Individuals residing in the following counties or cities are eligible to apply: *Accomack, Chesapeake, Hampton, Isle of Wight, Newport News, Norfolk, Northampton, Poquoson, Portsmouth, Suffolk, Virginia Beach, Williamsburg and York as well as zip codes in the State of North Carolina beginning with 279.*

2nd Priority: Any individual residing in the State of Virginia, USA attending or planning to attend an accredited college or university program anywhere.

3rd Priority: Any individual residing in the mid-Atlantic region, USA, including Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Washington DC, Virginia, New York and West Virginia, who is attending or planning to attend an accredited college or university program anywhere.
