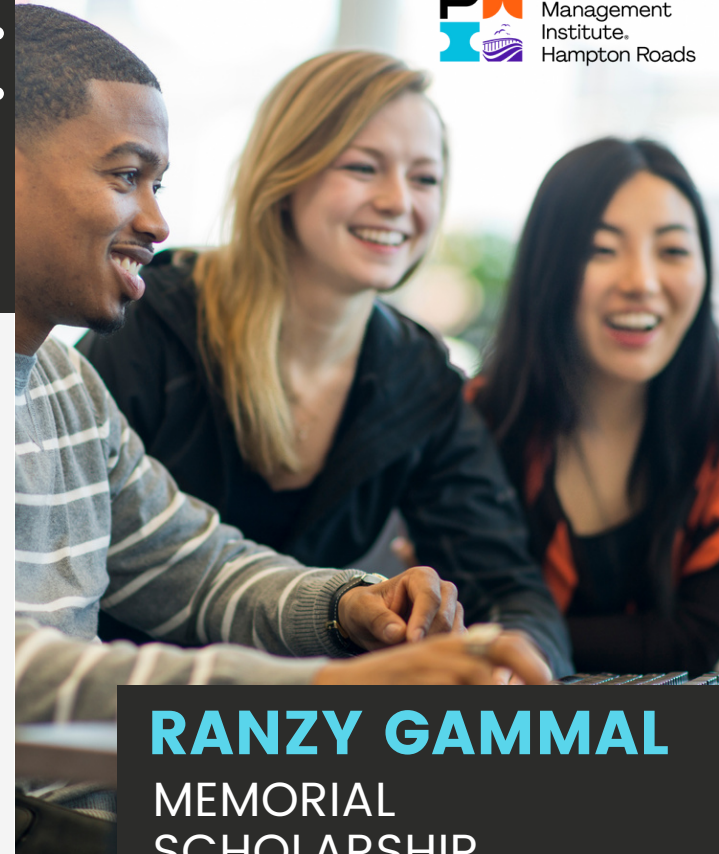

Amount: \$2,500 USD

Open Date: April 15th

Deadline: August 15, 2024

Frequency: Annually

CRITERIA

Applicants must be enrolled in or applying for an accredited undergraduate or graduate degree program in project management, and/or a field that benefits from project management (e.g., architecture, science/engineering, hotel management, information technology, pharmaceutical, business administration, construction, human resources, or educational administration), with the following order of priority:

1. Any individual residing in the Hampton Roads area who is attending or planning to attend an accredited college or university program anywhere
2. Any individual residing in the state of Virginia who is attending or planning to attend an accredited college or university program anywhere
3. Any individual residing in the mid-Atlantic region who is attending or planning to attend an accredited college or university program anywhere

02. COMPLETE YOUR APPLICATION

Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria: GPA, academic achievements, school and community involvement, and a written essay.

03. SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

All applicants will be notified via email within three months after the deadline. Upon award, the scholarship funds will be given to the honoree's educational institution within three months.
